

BOATING ON LAKE LEANN

Operate in a counterclockwise direction around lake at all times
(Except when picking up a downed skier or tuber)

Low speed – no wake –operation

Within 100 feet of shore
Within 100 feet of swimming areas
Within 100 feet of moored boats
In ALL Bays and channels leading to bays as indicated by buoys

High speed Operation and Water Skiing

Must have an observer
Must wear personal flotation device type I, II, if less than 12 years
Or type I, II, or III if 12 or older when skiing or tubing
Only between the hours of 8 a.m. and one hour before sunset if towed behind a Personal Water Craft (PWC)
and
One hour before sunrise and One hour after sunset if towed behind a boat

Personal Watercraft

Any child under the age of 7 on a PWC must be with a parent or designee of parent or guardian

No person under the age of 12 may operate a PWC

A person 12 or more and less than 14 may operate a PWC only if
He or she obtained a boating safety certificate prior to January 1, 1999 or
The person is accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian and both person and parent or legal guardian have
obtained a boating safety certificate and the PWC

Those 14 years or older born after December 31, 1978 may operate a PWC only if
He or she has obtained a boating safety certificate
Those born December 31, 1978 or earlier may operate a PWC without restrictions

PWC shall NOT cross within 150 ft behind another vessel

Additional Rules

No buoys, signs, or swim area markers may be moved or removed without the approval of the Board of Directors

No additional signage may be placed in the waters of Lake Leann without the approval of the Board of Directors.
Unapproved signs will be removed by officials of the Association.

All floating rafts shall be no more than the shortest distance of:
Fifty (50) feet from shore or
Twenty-five (25) feet from the end of any dock or pier (See rules for dock length and placement)

Please be safety conscious and courteous and have a great time at Lake Leann
