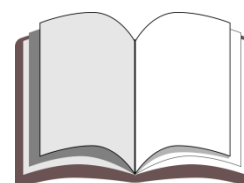
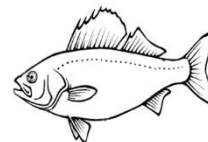


Small Groups

Ginger Crinkles

Ingredients:

2/3 cup Oil
1 cup Granulated Sugar
1 Egg
4 Tbs. Molasses
2 tsp. Baking Soda
1/2 tsp. Salt
1 tsp. Ground Ginger
2 cups All Purpose Flour



Instructions:

1. Combine oil and sugar
2. Add egg, molasses, baking soda, salt & ginger, and mix well
3. Slowly add flour while continuing to mix
4. Form dough into one inch balls and roll in granulated sugar
5. Place on ungreased cookie sheet and bake at 350°F for 15 mins
