## Irish Soda Bread Recipe

### Ingredients:

- 4 cups All Purpose Flour
- ½ cup Granulated Sugar
- 1 Tb. Baking Soda
- 2 tsp. Baking Powder
- 1 tsp. Salt
- 2 Tb. Caraway Seeds
- 1-1 ½ cups Raisins
- 1 ½ + cups Buttermilk



### Instructions:

1. Mix dry ingredients together first
2. Add in caraway seeds and raisins
3. Stir in buttermilk and mix well (add a bit more buttermilk if too dry)
4. Knead lightly and form log
5. Cut log into two or more pieces and form a circle. Place on cookie sheet
6. Cut cross on top of circle about ¼ inch deep across loaf and sprinkle with granulated sugar
7. Bake at 375°F until browned and when tapped on bottom sounds hollow (around 30 minutes for larger loafs and less for smaller)
8. Slice and spread with butter
