- ❖ Restorative Lake Sciences (RLS) is our NEW Lake Manager with the goal to develop a plan for improvement of our lake water quality
- ❖ PLM is back to do our lake Treatments for 2019
- ❖ Please try to refrain from making a wake near the shoreline for 72 hours after a treatment has been applied. This gives the treatment a chance to work without interruption. We will try to arrange treatments early in the week so we don't interfere with your weekend activity
- ❖ The LLPOA follows the Handbook of Michigan Boating Laws and Responsibilities (Check the LLPOA website for the 2019 changes)
- ❖ Rake leaves and yard waste and dispose of instead of burning.
- ❖ No dumping of leaves or weeds in the lake
- ❖ Do Not burn near shoreline. (stay least 25' back and try to keep it contained) The potential ash runoff adds phosphorus to our lakes and feeds the algae
- ❖ Clean up all pet waste and dispose of in the trash
- ❖ Service your septic system on a regular basis
- ❖ Abide by all no wake rules at all times
- ❖ Always follow the counter clockwise directions at ALL TIMES. No shortcuts!
- ❖ Carry all required safety equipment on all watercraft
- ❖ Please try to refrain from having water balloon fights on the lake. The latex balloons take 6 months to 4 years to decompose and are an environmental hazard to the aquatic life in our lakes....Try a "Water Blaster" or similar products instead
