Dear Member's,

Throughout the summer we have been working with the LLPOA to develop an action plan regarding weed and algae treatments to best manage your lake. We understand there was a sudden change in lake conditions over the weekend regarding the planktonic algae bloom. These blooms can happen when weather conditions are right and an abundance of nutrients are available in the water. This year has been terrible for algae on a lot of lakes in the state of Michigan based on the weather patterns we have experienced, Lake LeAnn is no exception. We have been performing treatments on your lake every 14 days for algae control. With this recent bloom we will change up our treatment protocol for the immediate future by moving to weekly visits. With planktonic algae, we need to be careful to not cause oxygen depletion in the lake from sudden major die-off of algae and have to restrict the amount of area sprayed. With that said, we are strategically treating different areas of the lake as to not cause this to happen and have adverse effects on the fish habitat. Please be mindful of the treatment areas as they will change weekly and we will do our best to manage the algae bloom in the safest and quickest manor possible. We understand your concern and we are working as efficiently as possible to address this situation. Clarke will be on site every 7 days until we have this algae bloom under control. Algae blooms are unpredictable and we hope this might bring some clarity to the plan moving forward.
